

OnSite Theatre Company Celebrates Five Seasons with *Bowling Epiphany – The Revival!*

OnSite Theatre Company announces *Bowling Epiphany – The Revival!*, the much-requested return of its first ever production in celebration of five years of bringing exciting site-specific theatre to St. Louis.

Set in one of St. Louis' last remaining Catholic Church bowling alleys, audience members actually get to bowl, drink and mingle while enjoying three smart and provocative plays, one by Carter Lewis and two by Dan Rubin, that occur organically in the space.

Bowling Epiphany – The Revival! runs 8 p.m., June 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 28, 29 & 30 at Epiphany Lanes, 3164 Ivanhoe Avenue, St. Louis, MO. The play is directed by Joe Hanrahan and the cast includes Donna Weinsting, Antonio Rodriguez, and Elizabeth Birkenmeier.

“We are incredibly excited to be re-producing this show. Not only does it fulfill our mission of making theatre more approachable, it just makes for a really fun evening,” says Kristen Edler, Managing Director and co-founder of OnSite Theatre Company (along with Ann Marie Mohr, Artistic Director).

The evening consists of three short plays beginning with Carter Lewis' *Anarchy of a Pinpicker*. With a strange and surprising twist, *Anarchy of a Pinpicker* confirms the notion that you never know who you'll run into at a bowling alley. Next, Dan Rubin's *Gardenofeve(dot)com* allows us to eavesdrop on an awkward first bowling date of a young couple that are rarely emotionally connected, but always technologically connected. Finally, Rubin's *What Would Jesus Bowl* gives us a sneak peak at the ultimate bowling match-up: God vs. Satan.

Previous OnSite Theatre Company shows include *Huckleberry Hostel*, set in Soulard's Huck Finn Youth Hostel and *Hit-Story*, set in a gym and boxing training center.
